

ORDER

Advocate Mr. Ravish Bhatt is present for the Applicant in IA No. 276/2018.

The Learned lawyer appearing on behalf of the RP has filed the present application under section 12(2) of the IB Code for the extension of time for the further period of 90<sup>days</sup> beyond 180 days for the completion of the CIRP process as provided under section 12(2) of the Code.

It is informed that a statutory period of 180 days is going to expire ~~expired~~ on 19.08.2018 and the instant application was filed on 25.07.2018. 

Heard the arguments of learned Counsel for the Applicant.







On a perusal of the record of the case it may be seen that COC in its 5<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 04.07.2018 has passed a resolution to seek extension of time and has duly authorised the RP for the same, during the CIRP process. The above stated fact is reflected in clause No.3 on the extract of voting result at page no. 70 of the application in respect of resolution dated 04.07.2018 seeking for extension of the period as all the member of the COC has agreed for the said extension of time.

Considering the aforesaid reasons as mentioned in the application we being adjudicating Authority are of the view that sufficient reasons are shown for seeking extension of the period of the CIRP in respect of Corporate Debtor. Hence, prayer for extension of the CIRP period of 90 days beyond 180 days is hereby granted.

Accordingly, The IA is allowed and stands disposed of.
